### **III.** Essential Functions

Maintain daily maintenance of courts and areas adjacent to courts; maintain and repair tennis maintenance machines and equipment.

# IV. Additional Responsibilities

- 1. Waters, rolls, drags surface, and sweeps lines of clay courts
- 2. Blows debris and dust from surface of hard courts
- 3. Builds up low spots, shaves high spots, dusts, (plugs feathers material) on all clay courts
- 4. Keeps court tapes, nets, fences and gates in good condition
- 5. Applies calcium chloride on clay courts
- 6. Blows sidewalks; empties trash from court and facility receptacles
- 7. Maintains court coolers, ice chest, and tennis shoe cleaners
- 8. Cleans shop windows
- 9. Blows and cleans terrace areas. Puts chairs in neat order and empties ashtrays
- 10. Replenishes supplies such as ice, towels, and cups
- 11. Trims grass at court edges, and prevents weed growth at court edges
- 12. Cleans court drainage gutters, drains, and catch basins; installs, takes down, and repairs court wind screens
- 13. Keeps desk personnel informed as to court conditions
- 14. Performs any additional tasks needed to keep tennis courts and surrounding areas in good order
- 15. Tunes, changes oil, greases, and fuels maintenance machines and equipment
- 16. Repairs machines and replaces defective or worn parts of all maintenance machines
